How does it happen?

> Touching sick animals—e.g., a Dog, cat.



> Children are vulnerable to infections coming from rodents and fleas.



> Drinking unpasteurized milk.

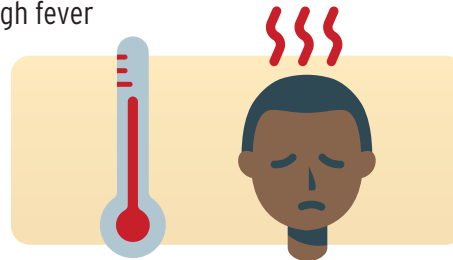


> Mosquito bites.



What are the danger signs?

> High fever



> Using a lot of energy or weakness



> Not eating



> Vomiting



> Difficulty breathing



What should I do?

> Take your child to the clinic within 24 hours.
